Introduction



Dear readers,

I am pleased to be able to present you with the second revised version of the brochure „Psychiatry in Berlin – Information and Orientation”.

Mental illnesses can have an especially strong impact in restricting the quality of life of the people they affect, as their daily routine is to a great degree influenced by social and health constraints as well as by personal circumstances. Various studies into the frequency and effects of mental illnesses are a welcome sign of an increased interest in this clinical picture, their findings indicating the advantages of treatment at an early stage.

The current brochure is intended to provide an overview of psychiatric care services available in Berlin. In the first section there is an outline of the contents, objectives and main terminology of psychiatry. Contexts and explanations to the individual „building blocks“ of the help system are included, which will be of assistance to those affected, their families, professionals and other interested persons. The second section gives an overview of the institutions and services dealing with the treatment, counselling, support and emergency care for people suffering from mental or addictive disorders, as well as showing the distribution of these institutions in Berlin with easy access to residents in all parts of the city.

It is particularly important to me to further improve the compulsory psychiatric care services in Berlin. This includes achieving an even better quality of care, for example via visiting committees.

Along with the German edition this guide on psychiatric help has already appeared in five of the most commonly

spoken foreign languages in our city. All the editions are available for downloading from my internet administration homepage.

I hope that this brochure will answer your questions, and be able to provide you with the first addresses for you to obtain psychiatric help.

Mental Health in Berlin



The possibility of becoming mentally ill is something that most people think has little to do with them. The reality however is quite different. According to a national health survey carried out in 1998, approximately 31% of German citizens between the ages of 18 and 64 will suffer from at least one mental disorder in the course of a year. Over 40% of sick-leave is connected with a mental disorder. At the same time, the rate of illness in Berlin is above the average and has continuously increased in recent years.

In the last 10 years, the Berlin local government, together with the district councils, welfare associations, hospitals as well as physicians and psychologists, have made immense efforts to develop the health care system for the mentally ill into one of the most efficient systems in the country.

The city has a strong network of psychiatric specialists, as well as medical and psychological psychotherapists, in all districts. In combination with their general practitioners, the majority of mentally ill people can receive the advice and treatment they need, while anyone requiring clinical treatment due to the severity of their illness can find it in a specialised department in their district. The age of large psychiatric hospitals on the outskirts of the city, in which mentally ill people were often treated for months or even years, is over. The length of in-patient stays has been drastically decreased through a close and coordinated co-operation with physicians and psychologists, therapeutic groups, day centres, as well as various kinds of aid and support facilities in the housing sector. The duration of in-patient treatment in Berlin is less than 20 days on average. The regional psychiatric care system concentrates particularly on people with chronic mental illnesses. The districts care for and bear responsibility for this group of people with social psychiatric services, contact and advice

centres, as well as a multitude of occupational activities and diverse services in supported housing as well as day centres.

With the "Berlin Crisis Service" (Berliner Krisendienst), the Berlin districts have built up a very special service for their citizens. From its nine locations distributed over the entire city, it offers, particularly in the evening and at night, professional advice to all those in a mental crisis, as well as their relatives, neighbours and friends, and will of course pay visits to those in need of help if and when necessary.

A mental illness is nothing exotic, which will probably never affect us. We encounter mentally ill people everyday in our social environment, and the likelihood that we will also require professional help at some point in our lives is not low. For this reason, Berlin with its psychiatric care system provides a sophisticated, highly qualified and community based treatment and support system. If you need advice and help, contact these services, the addresses of which you will find in the district directory.

As local representative for mental health, I encourage you to share your experiences with me. I will then ensure

that your suggestions are forwarded to the authority responsible. In this way you will help us to improve our services still further.

Berlin crisis service

The Berlin Crisis Service provides help and support to persons in acute mental distress and acute psychiatric crisis situations. People contact the crisis service for many different reasons: mental disorders or crises, such as depression, fears and panic attacks, separation and bereavement, addiction problems, conflicts within the family or a relationship, traumatic experiences, suicidal thoughts, etc. In principle, the person in need decides in what difficult situations he might require help.

The Berlin Crisis Service is also aimed at those in the affected person's immediate environment, such as partners, relatives, friends, colleagues or neighbours, as such people in their anxiety frequently require information and advice, or due to the great stress they suffer, may need support themselves.

The Berlin Crisis Service naturally offers its support to all professional care institutions as well as to the general emergency system. Physicians, therapists and institutional social workers, as well as the police and fire department, may avail themselves of the crisis services at any time, especially in emergencies.

The Berlin Crisis Service can be reached 365 days a year, 24 hours a day.

Berlin has nine counselling centres distributed throughout the city. They are open daily from 4 p.m. to midnight (the addresses and telephone numbers can be found on the district directory pages of this brochure and on the internet at www.berliner-krisendienst.de).

During this time, persons seeking help can obtain support over the phone or directly in one of the counselling centres. No appointment is needed and the assistance is free and anonymous on request.

In particularly urgent and intense situations, crisis service workers can travel to the site of the emergency. Some

physicians (specialists) remain on call and can quickly respond at any time.

Outside of these main opening times, the Berlin Crisis Service offers both support and assistance through its regional emergency service, day and night (midnight to 4 p.m.). You can find the counselling centre for this service in the Region Mitte (Krausnickstraße 12 A). Persons seeking help are put through automatically to the stand-by services from each of the Berlin Crisis Service telephone numbers (calls are automatically forwarded after midnight). The only exception is on work days (8 a.m. to 4 p.m.), when information is only given by telephone and referrals are made.

This is due to the fact that the Berlin Crisis Service is structured as a supplement to the existing psychiatric care system.

Social-psychiatric services

District health authorities in all Berlin districts have a department for social-psychiatric services, in some cases even at several locations in each district to make them easier to reach (see district directory).

The social psychiatric service workers (physicians, social workers, psychologists and administrative staff) offer assistance and support to adults with a (mostly chronic) mental illness, a substance abuse disorder or a mental disability.

Counselling, referrals and crisis intervention are offered in each department or during house calls to the person affected, his next of kin, as well as people in his social environment. The social psychiatric services work closely with other care partners on a regional and also national level. They make referrals for further in-patient and out-patient care or participate in the referral on the district

control board. Within the scope of the custody laws and the social welfare legislation, they act as consultants, make referrals and provide assessments.

The social psychiatric service workers can be reached Monday to Friday, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Late consultation hours are offered on Thursdays until 6 p.m.

During this time, the social psychiatric service is also responsible for emergency psychiatric care in its respective region. The primary goal is to exhaust all possibilities of providing assistance so that compulsory measures will not be necessary. In cases of danger to themselves or others, the physician will decide how to proceed in accordance with the laws regarding the mentally ill.

Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Service

The child and adolescent psychiatric services are counselling centres assigned to the Health or Youth Department within the district government offices.

Where problems arise in living with children and adolescents in cases of difficulties in upbringing and development problems, these services provide medical, psychological and social-educational examinations, assessments and consultation, as well as arranging for and accompanying assistance to children, youths and their families, especially in crisis situations. They also provide assistance within the framework of the right to care and housing.

The child and adolescent psychiatric services work closely with the child and adolescent health services and schools. They take part in assistance/provider conferences, advising specialists from the psycho-social care services and educational institutions about the problems of child and adolescent psychiatric care.

Counselling centres for alcohol and substance abuse

When the use of alcohol, prescription drugs and other substances such as nicotine or illegal drugs becomes a problem, the counselling centres for alcohol and substance abuse offer the possibility to obtain professional help. Besides providing assistance to the affected persons themselves, the centre also provides support for other affected persons such as next of kin, partners, friends or work colleagues.

The counselling centres provide addiction counselling and care and in some cases also treatment in the form of individual and group therapy. They give referrals for treatment geared towards withdrawal and giving up the habits, provide assistance with social and practical living issues as well as information on counselling services in other institutions such as debt counselling centres, education and family counselling centres or self-help groups. Counselling centres for people suffering from alcohol and substance abuse can be found in each district in Berlin. Some of them are run as integrated counselling centres i.e. drug counselling is provided on an organised basis in them.

Counselling, treatment, care in crisis

Contact and counselling centres

The contact and counselling centres are open to all interested persons who are affected by a mental disorder. Their services range from establishing contacts for recreational activities, for participation in group activities, to individual counselling sessions. Special activities and events such as group outings, excursions, cultural and sports activities, musical events or a hot lunch are also available in many of these centres. Additionally, self-help groups meet at these centres, where people can support one another with individual problems without professional guidance.

Various forms of services such as contact and counselling centres, additional earnings opportunities, day care centres and other forms of care, are frequently located and administrated in the day centres. This offers the people who visit the centre the advantage of receiving a more flexible and individualised service, which is adapted to suit their real life situation. For example, if necessary they can receive the support of a day care centre or they can try out opportunities to earn money.

Visitors at the Day Centre or those seeking to earn additional money can also take advantage of the opportunities at the Contact and Counselling Centre.

Adult clinical care

In-patient care

For especially serious disorders or in emergencies, mentally ill people and substance abusers will be given in-patient care, i.e. in the specialised departments for psychiatry and psychotherapy of a hospital. There is at least one such specialised department at a hospital or a psychiatric hospital in each district of Berlin. The hospitals are close-by and well known, and mental disorders will be treated under the same conditions as a physical disorder. You

will find the hospital responsible for your district on the directory pages at the back of this brochure.

The Centre for Intercultural Psychiatry, Psychotherapy and Supervision (Zentrum für interkulturelle Psychiatrie, Psychotherapie und Supervision / Schumannstr. 20/21, 10117 Berlin, telephone number (030) 450 517 095) of the Charité Hospital in Berlin-Mitte offers special services for people from migrant communities.

Day clinics

On weekdays the day clinic provides the possibility of partial in-patient treatment to those patients who have either completed their in-patient stay or do not require in-patient care, but for whom out-patient care is not sufficient. Patients spend the evenings, nights and week-ends in their normal environment. On the one hand, this makes the first big step out of hospital easier, in addition, it often even takes the place of in-patient care.

Out-patient care institutions

The out-patient care institution is connected to a specialised department for psychiatry and psychotherapy, which performs the out-patient treatment in preparation for or as follow-up to the hospital treatment. This is of special importance for the seriously ill and those in danger of relapsing, who would not go to a local doctor on a regular basis. In this way, the treatment can be carried out in a smooth transition on an out-patient basis.

Child and adolescent clinical care

In Berlin psychiatric and psychotherapeutic care services for children and adolescents are organised into six regions, each region comprising two adjacent districts. At present psychiatric hospital care for children and adolescents is

guaranteed at six locations. Day clinics and out-patient units are likewise available in each region.

In-patient care mainly serves the diagnosis and treatment of manifest child and adolescent psychiatric illnesses. This form of treatment should be undertaken only when all other treatment measures have been exhausted. The day clinic treatment has the advantage for the children and adolescents that they are not separated from their family and social environment.

You will find the hospital department responsible for child and adolescent psychiatry and psychotherapy in your district in the district directory.

Hospital order treatment

A special form of clinical psychiatric care is accommodation in a order treatment hospital. This hospitalisation is ordered by the court and it is not part of the regional psychiatric care system. With its two locations in Reinickendorf (Karl-Bonhoeffer-Nervenklinik) and Pankow (Klinikum Buch), it is operated by the Berlin local government. If a person commits a serious criminal offence and, due to a mental illness or drug abuse, is deemed not to be criminally liable or of diminished criminal responsibility, admission to a psychiatric hospital - in Berlin the order treatment hospital - will be ordered by the court. This serves not only the patient's own recovery and security, but also the prevention of crime, averting dangers, and public safety.

Registered physicians and therapists

The treatment of a mental illness is a statutory health insurance benefit and is provided by registered specialists in neurology, psychiatry and psychotherapy, psychosomatic medicine and psychotherapy, as well as psychological psychotherapy. Psychotherapy is only a statutory health insurance benefit and included in medical care provided by authorised physicians if it promotes the healing of or recovery from a mental illness or medical rehabilitation.

A patient telephone service (telephone number (030) 31003-222) was set up by the Association of Statutory Health Insurance Physicians (Kassenärztliche Vereinigung) in co-operation with the Berlin Medical Association (Ärztekammer Berlin). On phoning this number it is possible to obtain the telephone numbers and addresses of local doctors and therapists on working days from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. On the internet a search for registered specialists (for adults as well as children and adolescents) is available at www.kvberlin.de, www.aerztekammer-berlin.de and www.psychotherapeutenkammer-berlin.de

Registered child and adolescent physicians and therapists.

The great variety of manifestations and progressive stages of mental disorders and illnesses in childhood and adolescence necessitates the clarification of the originating and characterising interrelationships between physical, developmental psychology and social factors. An intensive collaboration between the attending specialists (e.g. paediatricians and adolescent psychiatric specialists) and therapists (psychological psychotherapists, child and adolescent psychotherapists) with the child and adolescent services and the school system is frequently indispensable in order to be able to guarantee the best possible treatment

for the patients and their next of kin.

Registered specialists for child and adolescent psychiatry and psychotherapy as well as psychotherapists are not always to be found within easy reach in Berlin. Information about these specialists is provided by the Berlin Association of Statutory Health Insurance Physicians, telephone (030) 31 00 32 22 or on the internet at www.kvberlin.de, www.aerztekammer-berlin.de or www.psychotherapeutenkammer-berlin.de.

Immigrants

Immigrants and their families make up around 14% of the population of Berlin, and are just as affected by mental disorders as those of German nationality. Therefore the psychiatric care services are available to all the residents of Berlin without discrimination. In practice however it has been necessary to take into account the special requirements of a cultural or religious nature in the treatment and counselling of immigrants.

A service with this especially in mind has been created – ZIPP (Centre for Intercultural Psychiatry, Psychotherapy and Supervision) at Charité Berlin, Campus Mitte. Together with research, further training and intercultural supervision an ethnopsychiatric out-patients unit using an intercultural approach has been set up.

A significant aspect in the further development of psychiatric care services overall will be the deeper integration and recognition of intercultural skills in the various services, while at the same time necessitating more intensive efforts to avoid failure due to the language barrier. One step in this direction is this brochure, which appears not only in German but also in English, Polish, Russian, Serbo/Croat/Bosnian and Turkish.

Housing and structuring of daily life

District steering committees

For mentally ill people who apply for social benefits in accordance with the Social Security Act XII (Sozialgesetzbuch XII, SGB XII), the allocation of these benefits is carried out with the co-operation of the district steering committees. In these committees, the current aid requirements of an affected person are assessed and measures suited to his needs are suggested. This can, for example, be care in a therapeutic shared residence, individual care in one's home, day care, as well as especially intensive care in temporary accommodation (halfway house). Thus a broad spectrum of very individualised assistance is available. The members of this committee are, as a rule, the service providers, the financiers (case management), the in-patient hospital sector, the social psychiatric services, the psychiatry coordination, the further services of the psychiatric care region as well as the persons seeking assistance themselves, to the extent they wish to do so.

Assisted living accommodation

Assisted living accommodation provides the mentally ill and substance abuser with help in meeting daily needs such as planning his activities, making social contacts and support in searching for vocational activities, work and training possibilities. Both objectives, as well as the range of concrete services, will depend on the individual needs of the person in care. Apart from care in one's own home, in a shared residence or in co-operation with assisted accommodations (out-patient care homes), there is also care in residential care facilities and halfway houses (a in-patient form).

The district steering committees assign clients to the various forms of assisted living accommodation.

In addition to assisted living accommodation provided by each of the 12 Berlin districts on the basis of regionalized mandatory care, the Berlin local government itself offers some assisted living accommodation. For example, assisted housing for mentally ill gay men, for suicidal mentally ill young adults, for mentally ill drug addicts and for women with addictions.

You can obtain further information from the psychiatric coordinator or the steering committee in your district.

Day centres

The mentally ill and drug abusers are cared for during the day in a day centre away from their own homes. As with assisted living accommodations, it offers help with planning daily life, making social contacts, support in finding vocational opportunities, work and training. Moreover, it offers guided group activities as well as occupational services.

Work, vocational activities and training

Work plays a central role in the life of every person. That also applies to people with severe mental disorders. Even after retirement due to mental illness, the question of daily activity still remains, since very few people can, or want to and should be treated and cared for the entire day.

Work is not only to be understood as a job on the regular labour market, but rather the variety of vocational opportunities possible. These can include, for example, voluntary activities, occupational day centres, work and occupational therapy, hourly paid jobs on the side, occupation in a workshop for disabled people, attendance at training schemes at the job centre, school, occupational training, entering into an employment relationship in an integration company, and so on. A directory "Social Firms Berlin" ("Soziale Unternehmen Berlin") has been published directly for the people in the affected person's direct environment in which the possibilities of rehabilitation, integration and ways of earning extra money are described. Furthermore there are possibilities for vocational training adapted to the needs of adolescents suffering from mental disorders. This training takes place in educational institutes (in Berlin in BBW-RKI: www.drk-berlin.de/rkinstitut/index.htm). Any queries on financial support and registering will be dealt with by the relevant employment centre (Arbeitsagentur)

Additional earning

Work and occupational activities have a special meaning for people with a long history of mental illness. This includes participation in social life, organising their daily structure, self confidence and not least recognition in society, and providing one's life with meaning after long

years of exclusion from the labour market. The regional psychiatric care offers additional earnings opportunities, which in Berlin are partly publicly financed.

Additional earning opportunities provide low threshold occupation or work opportunities especially to chronically mentally ill people. The persons availing themselves of these opportunities can thereby try out various occupational fields after making arrangements with the flexible working hours. The additional earning opportunities offers take the performance capabilities of the chronic mentally ill person into account and are especially geared towards this. A small expense allowance will be paid.

Workshops for Disabled People

Workshops for disabled people service are aimed at disabled people who cannot, are not yet able or again not able to be occupied in the general labour market, however are in a position to work to a certain extent, thus fulfilling the admission requirements.

At the same time, the WfbM must take on all disabled people regardless of the form and degree of their disability.

An introductory procedure to determine whether the WfbM is the suitable facility in a given case is generally followed by 2-year vocational training sponsorship in order to improve participation in working life. For disabled people who, upon completion of these measures, cannot find work either in the general job market or in occupational educational or training courses, the workshops offer a broad variety of jobs, taking into account to the greatest possible extent the different individual performance capabilities, possibilities for development, as well as aptitude and preferences.

In numerous centres there are at present over 7.100 workshop

places offered by 17 workshop providers distributed over the entire city. In addition to five workshop providers specialising in sponsoring mentally ill people, all other workshops will accept mentally ill people.

Information on professional integration in workshops for disabled people is provided by the rehabilitation service providers and especially the social security benefits providers (district authorities - Bezirksämter), the local agency for employment (Bundesagentur für Arbeit, Arbeitsagenturen) and the administrators of the pension schemes (BfA, LVA, etc.). Naturally, information can be also obtained at all workshop providers. Integration Projects

Integration projects provide jobs to people with a disability, for whom integration in other occupations in the general labour market meets with difficulties due to the form and degree of the disability. This especially applies to people with a mental disability or illness, with a serious physical, sensory impairment or multiple disabilities. Those who have left workshops for disabled people and special schools are also included in the integration projects' target group.

In contrast to other companies in the general labour market, integration projects provide their severely disabled employees with care while at work by social pedagogically

trained staff. Profit margins alone do not determine the enterprising action.

The entrepreneurial purpose is first and foremost employing severely disabled people and furthering their professional and social participation.

There are 15 integration projects in Berlin with a total of 535 employees, of which 250 people with disabilities are active in service areas such as gardening and landscaping, cleaning of buildings, painting and decorating, restaurants, a whole wheat bakery and catering services.

Associations of affected persons

The associations of mentally ill people are a building block in the representation of the interests of affected persons. In December 2003, the Regional Working Group Berlin (Landesarbeitsgemeinschaft Berlin) was founded in the BPE as an unregistered association. The purpose of the association is the formation of self-help groups, the exchange of information and experiences, public relations, and the representation of Berlin residents who experienced psychiatric treatment at all levels by sending delegates.

Support for family members

When a family member is mentally ill, this illness also often presents the relatives with a great challenge. Self-help

Self-help is a component of reciprocal support and information for affected persons which plays an indispensable role in the Berlin health and social system. Many self-help groups meet, for example, in contact and counselling centres for people with mental illness, substance abuse centres or at local centres which are located in each district.

If you are looking for a self-help group for your symptoms or would like to form such a group yourself, you can turn to these institutions.

Complaint departments

The complaint departments are directed towards citizens who suffer from mental disorders and impairment or are affected as a family member. The complaint departments take up suggestions and complaints as long as they relate to medical or other out-patient treatment/therapy or psycho-social care in a non-clinical setting. They provide advice (but not legal advice!) and support to the claimant exercising his rights.

The complaint department operates as an independent authority with the psychiatric and psycho-social care institutions and endeavours to arrive at a mutually agreeable solution in the interests of all parties involved. At the moment independent complaint departments are not yet available all over Berlin. You will find the existing services in the district directory.

Planning, cooperation and networks

Psychiatric advisory boards

Regional psychiatric advisory board

The Berlin Senator of Health will appoint a psychiatry advisory board of specialists to advise him on all matters dealing with the care of mentally ill people in a manner which meets their needs. The legal basis for the appointment and activities of the Psychiatry Advisory Board in Berlin is provided by the Berlin Law for the Mentally Ill.

Psychiatry advisory boards for the districts

Analogous to the regional psychiatry advisory board, a psychiatry advisory board comprising of specialists, which advises the district councillor responsible for public health on all questions involving the care of mentally ill people in a manner which meets their needs is also appointed in the districts. The legal basis for the appointment and activities of the Psychiatry Advisory Board is the Berlin law for Public Health Services (Berliner Gesetz über den öffentlichen Gesundheitsdienst).

Mental health coordination

With the increased responsibility of the districts to provide help for mentally ill people, the need for coordination and control in the district health system has also increased. In this, the mental health coordinators who are established in all of the Berlin districts play a central role. Their area of responsibility lies in the planning, control and coordination of the community psychiatric care services in close co-operation with the care providers. They are contact persons not only for the affected people and their relatives, but, at the same time, also for the staff members of the services and facilities on matters of psychiatric treatment, care and nursing. The qualitative further development and adaptation of the psychiatric care system to new treatments and

forms of care and statutory framework conditions are the continuing tasks of the mental health coordinators.

Addiction and substance abuse coordination

Along with the psychiatry coordination, substance abuse coordinators and representatives are active in all districts of Berlin. Their tasks and function are performed in the districts with various points of concentration. In essence, the substance abuse coordinators are involved with ascertaining the needs, the development and the coordination of the services in the substance abuse help system. They also give advice and information to substance abuse specialists, and in individual cases, to the affected persons.

They are available as contact persons to all services and institutions dealing with drug and substance abuse problems.

Contacts are named on the district directory pages.

Psycho-social Working Group

In the Psycho-social Working Group, psychiatry experts from institutions, authorities, associations, as well as affected persons and relatives of mentally ill people in a district, meet to discuss issues concerning care in the district. The Psycho-social Working Group works toward a collaboration of all persons involved in the care of mentally ill people and must be heard by the competent authorities responsible for carrying out the task of ensuring community based psychiatric care.

Planning, cooperation and networks

Associations

In response to the increasing demands on the quality of care, a few districts have formed psychiatric associations in recent years. In such associations, service providers and institutions of a region or district join together in order to improve the care of the mentally ill and/or people with addictive disorders by more effectively implementing and deploying the available services.

The obligatory network of assistance services enables, for example, a better transition of people treated in a hospital to the out-patient area (general practitioners). The continuity of treatment, nursing, and care of an affected person can in most cases be better guaranteed in an association. This avoids repeated stays in clinics or premature admissions to care facilities. In associations, defects and bottlenecks in the care can be seen and removed more quickly. Joint further and advanced education services can secure the quality of the association's work.

There are the following forms of association in Berlin:

- Community psychiatric association
- Geriatric and gerontological psychiatric associations
- Addiction and substance abuse associations

In the community psychiatric association, the administrators of the institutions and of psychiatric care services, the service providers, affected persons and relatives, all come together under the leadership of the district with the goal of building up and further developing the community psychiatric help network, orientated to individual cases.

This form of association is presently being developed and tested in the Reinickendorf district.

The geriatric and gerontological psychiatric association is an amalgamation of geriatric aid institutions and psychiatric assistance in one care region, in order to enable physically and mentally disturbed people, and the elderly to receive care in accordance with their individual needs. These associations have been set up in all districts.

In the substance abuse association, administrators and institutions of a district who are active in the area of addiction prevention and assistance to people with addictive disorders work closely together. The goal is to secure and improve the quality of life of people in danger of addiction and people with addictive disorders. Substance abuse co-operations do not yet exist in all districts.

Connections to other care systems

Homeless people

The facilities assisting the homeless in Berlin can be a starting point for the homeless or for people threatened by homelessness. You can find out which institution can best meet your needs and what additional aid would be most useful for you in the district offices (Bezirksamt). Every district office has a social housing office (Soziale Wohnhilfe) that will provide you with assistance. If above and beyond the homelessness, additional aid is required due to a mental illness or a substance abuse disorder, the social-psychiatric services in the district are available as a contact point for this purpose.

Addiction and substance abuse care system

Aid for dependency and drug addiction covers a wide spectrum of services. Low threshold contact services provide survival aid without preconditions and serve, along with the direct care, to motivate addicts to take the first step out of addiction and dependency. This also includes street work to locate them, for example. Counselling centres inform, advise and accompany addicts and are helpful in referring them to more far-reaching services. Out-patient and in-patient institutions offer longer term treatment for combating the addiction. Substitution services and follow-up care supplement this spectrum of aid.

The uppermost goal is: "every person affected who wants to do something about their addiction should receive the necessary aid"¹.

Elderly people in need of care

Basically all of the components of the mental health care system in a district are open to elderly people with a mental illness. For people in need of care who are entitled to financial support from the Nursing Care Act checks should be made on an individual basis to determine which form of assistance best caters to their needs.

Nursing services can be provided by the service providers of the elderly aid system either on an out-patient basis (home nursing care, assisted living accommodation), a partly in-patient basis (day care, short-term care) or an in-patient basis (residential facilities). Moreover with the passing in 2002 of the Nursing Care Entitlement Amendment, aimed at people in need due to severely restricted daily living skills – i.e. people with mental dementia and other mental disorders – additional counselling and care services – out-patient care or low-threshold counselling services was made available. More information is obtainable on the internet under www.berlin.de/pflege/ or from public health care offices. This wide range of counselling and care services for the elderly is also available to affected persons and their relatives in crisis situations. In order to optimally coordinate this aid to suit the requirements of each individual case, geriatric-gerontopsychiatric associations were set up to support people with mental impairment and their families.

The goal of this binding collaboration is in particular to avoid repeated stays in clinics or the too early admission of an affected person to a residential facility. Information about services for gerontopsychiatric care may be obtained from the district mental health coordinators and from the Social Services Department (Abteilung Sozialwesen) responsible for elderly aid planning in every district.
